Guidelines for Seminar Report:

- The report should be typed and properly formatted.
- It must include the following sections:
 - Title Page
 - Abstract
 - Introduction
 - Literature Review
 - Methodology / Technical Content
 - Results/Discussion (if applicable)
 - Conclusion
 - References (IEEE format preferred)
- The report should be well-structured, plagiarism-free, and technically sound.
- Proper figures, diagrams, and tables should be included wherever necessary.
- The report must be duly approved/signed by the concerned faculty/mentor (if applicable).

Guidelines for PowerPoint Presentation (PPT):

- Duration of presentation: 15-20 minutes, followed by Q&A session.
- PPT should include:
 - Title Slide (Topic, Name, Enrollment No.)
 - Introduction and Background
 - Problem Statement/Objectives
 - Methodology / Technical Details
 - Key Findings / Analysis
 - Conclusion and Future Scope
 - References
- Slides should be clear, concise, and visually effective (avoid overcrowding of text).
- Use of diagrams, graphs, and illustrations is encouraged.

General Instructions:

- All students must report at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled time.
- Attendance during the seminar is mandatory.
- Students must carry both soft and hard copies of their seminar report.
- Evaluation shall be based on technical content, presentation skills, report quality, and response to questions.

Failure to comply with the above instructions may affect the evaluation of the course.
